 - \circ International students will be taxed 30%
 - Can be exempt, paperwork has been shared with leadership. Update to come.
 - Tax is taken off the top for international students
 - Payment is a 1099; tax comes off the back-end for domestic students

 - Still being utilized
 - Everett has 3 free times per year
 - Local counselor
 - Vancouver is struggling with under-utilization
 - Reached to UW, Central, Western and all campuses seem to be having this issue
 - Health Sciences has seen incline in health services
 - Out-of-state telemedicine
 - Tri-cities has one counselor and one for veterans
 - Overall stigma of seeking help
 - Resources appear to be reactive and not proactive
 - Casual group activities may help avoid crisis
- Social Engagement
 - Global has decreased attendance at meetings
 - Health Sciences is keeping engaged for social media
 - Tri-Cities is also staying successful with socials
